Dear Parents/Guardians;

Like many schools, Crossing Park is projected to be over capacity and is unable to accommodate all students who live in Martindale for the 2024-2025 school year and beyond.

As a result, we will continue to have a cap on students entering grade 7. This measure **caps our Junior High population only.**

A lottery will be held again this year. Martindale students currently in Grade 6 entering Grade 7 in 2024-2025 will be a part of the CBE lottery process. This includes our own school and feeder schools.

If unsuccessful in the lottery process, students will attend the designated overflow school. Students who are **not** selected in the lottery process will be designated to the overflow school and placed on a call-back list in a numerical order. We do not have an exact number of students who will be redirected at this time.

Crossing Park School will host a parent/guardian information evening on Monday, February 12 from 5:30 to 6:30pm. This in-person event will provide an opportunity for parents/guardians to ask questions or raise concerns. Principals from all 3 schools impacted will be in attendance.

Grade 6 students in the Martindale community, currently attending Crossing Park School and Manmeet Singh Bhullar School, will automatically be included in the lottery for Grade 7 at Crossing Park School.

If unsuccessful in the lottery, students from both Crossing Park and Manmeet Singh Bhullar will automatically be registered at the overflow school, Clarence Sansom School in the Pineridge community.

Crossing Park School

Dear Parent and Guardians,

CBE has had the opportunity to open several new schools recently; we find in some areas schools are still challenged to provide accommodation in programs of choice.

It would be ideal for all students to attend their school of choice, as close to home as possible; however, this is not always possible. Lotteries are a necessity when a school's enrolment passes the school's capacity.

The lottery process provides straightforward answers for school administrators, school councils and parents about the order in which students are accepted into the school.

The criteria for order of acceptance are as follows:

Priority 1	Students residing within the walk zone who have a sibling attending the school at the time of registration (see individual school profile pages for maps)
Priority 2	Students living outside the walk zone who will have a sibling in the same program in the same school at the same time OR Students living within the walk zone who do not have a sibling in the school / program
Priority 3	All other students living in the designated community.

All lottery draws are to take place on the Wednesday prior to Teachers' Convention.

To be considered for the lottery, registrations for the regular program or expressions of interest for alternative programs must be in place by noon the day before the draw.

Lottery draws will be supervised by more than one person, including the school principal or administrative delegate. All registrations will be assigned a number and an accurate record of the lottery will be created and maintained.

If an acceptance or call back is refused, the student comes off the list. If the refusal is based on the inability to take all members of a family, the student may remain on the list and be recalled if there is space for all.
